The Dial as shown above has three scales. The upper scale in red is for Kodachrome, the upper black scale for black and white movie film and the lower scale for black and white still film. The calibrations on each of the scales are widely

spaced, and can be easily read under practically any light conditions.

Electrophot depends only on the ability to see the subject in the Reflex view-finder.

The Rhamstine Electronic photocell does the rest.

The needle instantly indicates the lens setting—and that's all there is to it.

In addition to direct reading in "f" stops for Kodachrome it also reads direct for black and white film for both movies and stills as before. It is held in a natural manner, and the scene reflected in a view finder, just the same as holding and using a still camera. There are no

wheels or dials to turn and in the great majority of cases no calculations of any kind to make. Just read the scale.

A genuine leather carrying case is available, which is so arranged that the ELECTRO-PHOT may be used without removing from the case and even if removed the carrying strap prevents the loss of either the meter or the case.
